

Please follow the steps below for instructions on how to remove the Pulse Secure VPN client from your device(s). *Note: These instructions are not exhaustive and do not cover all types of configurations.*

## Windows 10

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The following are instructions on how to remove the Pulse Secure VPN client from your Windows device by using the *Add/Remove Program* feature located through the Control Panel.

1. On the Start menu, select *Control Panel*.
2. Under Programs, select *Uninstall a Program*.
3. Locate all *Pulse Secure*-related applications, select each, and click *Uninstall*.

4. Confirm the removal of all the applications.
5. Reboot your device, if necessary.

## Mac OS X

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The following are instructions on how to remove the Pulse Secure VPN client from your Mac OS X device by dragging and dropping the application to the device's Trash.

1. Ensure the Pulse Secure VPN client is not running. If it is running, right-click the icon,  located on the top header of the device, and select *Quit*.
2. Open the Finder application,  located at the bottom in the dock, and browse to *Applications*. Select *Pulse Secure*.
3. Click and drag the Pulse Secure icon to the *Trash* bin,  typically located at the bottom right hand of your dock.
4. The device may prompt you for the administrator password to continue.
5. Click *Yes* to remove the Pulse Secure VPN client.
6. Look in your Applications folder to ensure that Pulse Secure is no longer there.
