




Instructions:

1. In the search bar located at the bottom of the screen on the Windows Taskbar, type "Self Service" and press enter.



2. Once the Self Service Portal app window opens, select "Updates" from the options on the left.







3. Click "Update" below the "Step 1 – Windows 11 Upgrade" tile.



4. You will be prompted to begin the upgrade process. Press "Now" to continue and initiate the download.




5. Allow the download to complete fully.






Important: If you are prompted with a "UHealth Workstation Patch Updates Notification," please **Postpone** and allow the step 1 download process to complete.



If additional prompts appear, please select **Postpone** as well.






6. Once "Step 1 - Windows 11 Upgrade" is completed, a new tile will appear, allowing you to proceed with step 2 of the process. Click the "Update" button to begin the download.




7. Click "Now" to acknowledge the prompt for restart.








8. Upon completion of step 2, you will be prompted to reboot. Click "Restart Now" to finalize the upgrade.



Once the reboot has been completed, in the search bar located at the bottom of the screen on the Windows Taskbar, type "Check for updates" and press enter or click the icon.





10. Click the drop-down icon to the right of the "Check for updates" button and select "Check online for updates from Microsoft Update."

Allow all updates to be completed, then reboot once prompted.

Once you receive the message "You're up to date," the upgrade to Windows 11 is now fully complete.
