

How to remove the **eduroam** network from your computer

Please follow the steps below for instructions on how to remove the *eduroam* network from your computer. These instructions are not exhaustive and do not cover all types of configurations.

Windows 10

1. Click on the Windows menu and go to *Settings* (The gear wheel).
2. Select *Network & Internet*.
3. Scroll down past the list of available networks and select *Manage Wi-Fi settings*.
4. Within the Manage Wi-Fi settings scroll down to the bottom to the section that says Manage known networks.
5. Select the *eduroam* network, and click *Forget*.

Windows 8

1. Press the Windows key followed by “R” to open the run menu.
2. Type in ‘ netsh wlan delete profile name=“eduroam” ’ (case-sensitive) and press enter.

Windows Vista / Windows 7

1. Click on the Start Menu and then on the *Control Panel*.
2. Click on *Network and Internet*.
3. Under this new window, under the category of Network and Sharing Center, select “Manage wireless networks.”
4. Select the *eduroam* network, right-click, and select “Remove network.”

MAC OS X

1. Click on the Apple logo on the top left corner of your screen.
2. In the drop down menu click *System Preferences*.
3. Under the Internet & Wireless section click on Network.
4. On the left hand panel select Airport or Wi-Fi.
5. Click on *Advanced*.
6. Find the *eduroam* network in the list of Preferred Networks and select it.
7. Click on the “-” sign at the bottom to remove the profile.
8. Click on “OK” and then click on *Apply* to apply the changes.

Apple iOS

While on the University of Miami campus:

1. Tap on the settings icon on your home screen.
2. On the *Settings* screen, tap on *General*.
3. Scroll down until you see “*Profiles*”, and select the *eduroam* profile.
4. Click “*Remove Profile*,” you may be asked to enter your Passcode, enter it.
5. Select “*Remove*” again to remove the profile.

Android

1. Tap on the settings icon located in your Apps.
2. Under the Wireless & Networks, tap on the *Wi-Fi* settings and turn it on.
3. Scroll down the list of networks until you find the *CaneNet_Wireless* network. Press and hold that network, and select *Forget network*.
